### **Statement by Member of Parliament Michael BRAND - Germany**

Dear Juris, dear friends and supporters of Tibet!

On my own behalf and on behalf of our Group in the German Parliament, I deeply appreciate your organizing this important event in Riga today.

Together, we defend and promote human rights and the respect and appreciation for every culture on this planet, and the independence and well-being of nations.

That especially applies to the smaller nations that are threatened and attacked by brutal neighbors.

There is no need to explain that in Latvia these days.

The millennia-old civilization of Tibet is under an even greater threat.

Namely, China is implementing an utterly racist concept of clear supremacy that accepts only Han Chinese as the only truly justified race, which is strikingly reminiscent of racist Nazi ideology. China has embarked on an openly racist, repressive, and brutal path.

What is falsely labelled a so-called Ethnic Unity Law is in fact the opposite: it is a declaration of war against all non-Han Chinese ethnicities.

Its implementation will lead to what has been called genocide by UN experts.

Because ripping out the very roots of non-Chinese ethnicities is clearly destined to wipe out their very existence.

This deliberate war on the Tibetan nation and culture amounts to an attempt at genocide by Xi Jinping and his regime.

The Chinese leader is in great difficulty and has become ever more aggressive internally and externally.

The CCP has become a threat to peace, harmony, and stability in China and beyond. Therefore, we support initiatives that call out and stand up against that racist Chinese regime as a global threat to stability, peace, and human rights.

Events like the one today are sending a clear signal to a ruthless regime that the world will not stand by, but will keep fighting until we are finally able to celebrate a free Tibet, without any threat from China.
